








## Glossary

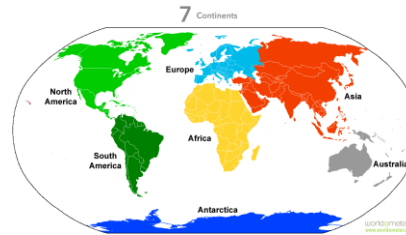
**Ocean**  a very large expanse of sea, in particular each of the main areas into which the sea is divided geographically

**Sea**  seas are smaller than oceans and are usually located where the land and ocean meet

**Continent**  large expanse of land that covers the world, Europe, Asia, Africa, North America, South America and Antarctica.

**Equator**  an invisible line which separates the North and South Hemisphere

**Pollution**  a substance which is harmful to the environment
