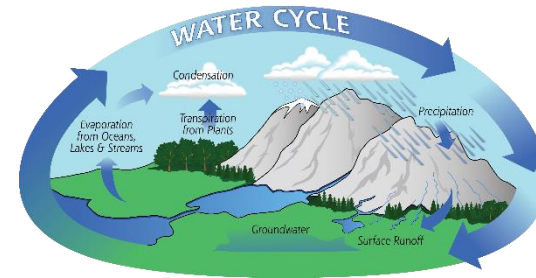


Year 6 Geography – Flooding/Rivers

Glossary

Topography— the arrangement of the human and physical features of an area

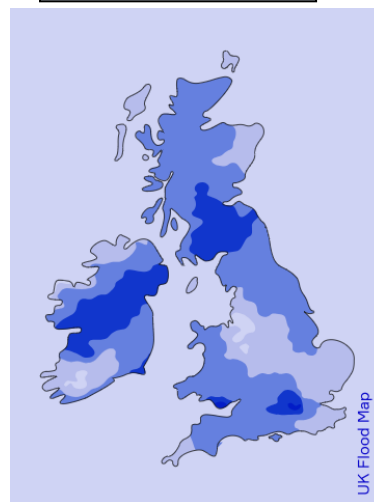
Precipitation— rain, snow, sleet or hail that falls to the ground

Source— the start of a river

Flood plain— an area of low-lying ground next to river which is subject to flooding
