vertebrate- animal with a backbone

invertebrate-animal without a backbone

herbivores-animal that eats plants and vegetation

carnivores-animals that eat meat

omnivores-animals that eat meat and plants

reptiles-cold blooded vertebrates with scales

fish-cold blooded vertebrate with fins and scales

amphibians-cold blooded vertebrate who can live underwater and on land

mammals-warm blooded vertebrates who give birth to live young

birds-warm blooded vertebrates who have wings and lay eggs
