## RE

Find out about who a Muslim is and what they believe (10 points)

Look at pictures of mosques from around the world - try drawing your favourite and write why you like it. (10 points)

Research about Islamic festivals - draw or write about how Muslims celebrate in the UK and around the world. (10 points)

Explore photos of henna patterns and then design your own. (3 points)

## MATHS

Practise your addition and subtraction within 10 - extend to 20 if you're confident (5 points)

Make number cards to 20 to use for the following activities:

Put them in order, an adult hides one, identify the missing number. (5 points)

Answer quick fire questions of one more or one less than any given number within 20. (3 points)

Choose three cards and put them in order from greatest to smallest, or smallest to greatest. (3 points)

Please make sure all your numbers are formed correctly.



## HISTORY

Draw a picture of either Florence Nightingale or Mary Seacole. (3 points)

Find a picture of Florence Nightingale's nursing uniform. Find another picture of a nurse today. What differences can you see? Record your answers. (10 points)

Create a fact-file on either Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale. (10 points each)

Draw a poster for why it's important to wash your hands. (5 points)

## PHONICS

Play games on Phonics Play (3 points/week completed)

Create a phonics board game and play it with your family e.g. say the phonics sound, sound out the words, find an object with the sound (10 points)

Pick a phonics grapheme (written sound) and write five words with this sound. Put these words into a sentence (5 points)

## English

Read some traditional tales, such as Cinderella, Three Little pigs, Rapunzel etc. Draw a story map (pictures and key vocab) for your story and retell to your teacher (10 points per story map)

Select some nouns (things, people, places) from the traditional tales and come up with adjectives to describe them. Record as a noun phrase e.g. shiny, golden crown (5 house points)

Put your noun phrases in to sentences about the traditional tale. (10 house points)

Write a diary one evening / weekend about what you've done. Try to include the features of a diary including date, first person and your feelings. (10 points)

## COMPUTING

Practise typing on a computer. (5 points)

Use directional language to move another person blindfolded around a room - use forwards, backwards, turn, left and right. Take it in turns. (5 points) For an extra challenge, can you give a list of instructions at the start? If it goes wrong, **debug** and make changes to your instruction. (5 points)
