Glossary

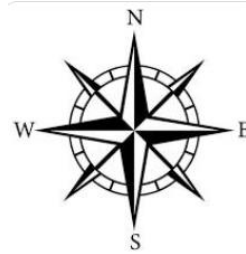
City: A city is a large settlement that usually has more than 100,000 people. It can include universities, stadiums and a cathedral.



Town: A mid-sized settlement that can have between 1,000 and 100,000 people. A town will usually have schools, train stations and hospitals.



Village: A small settlement that can have between 100 and approximately 3,000 people. It will usually be in the countryside and have some small services eg. Post office
