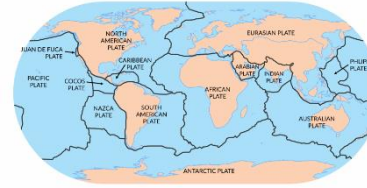

Tectonic plates



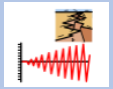
massive slab of rock made of Earth's lithosphere

Magnitude



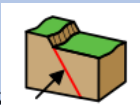
the size of the earthquake

Fault lines

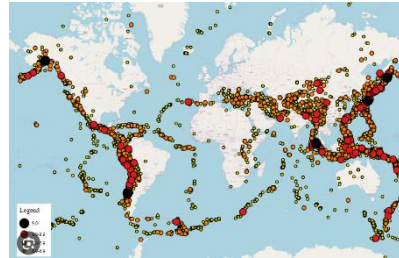


a long crack in the surface of the Earth

Richter Scale



scale by which the magnitude is measured
