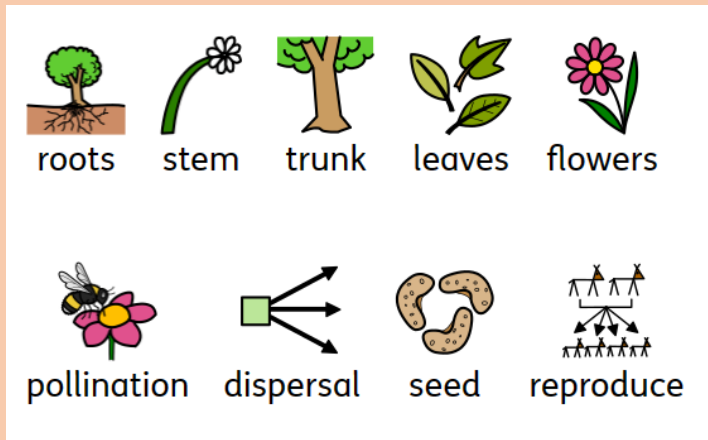


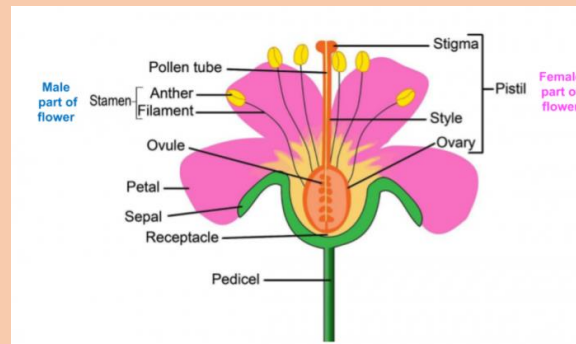

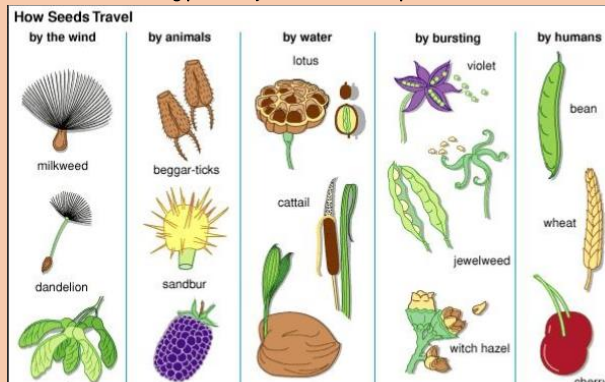
The function of the root is to give the plant stability

Water is transported within plants through the stem.

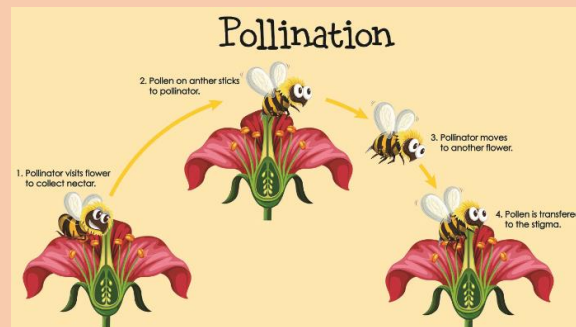
Flowers reproduce and disperse their seeds in different ways.
