Treaty of Versailles- ended WWI. Germany was forced to "accept the responsibility" of the war damages suffered by the Allies- UK, USA, Soviet Union. Countries working together

Alliance- Working together for the same cause

Conflict- to fight

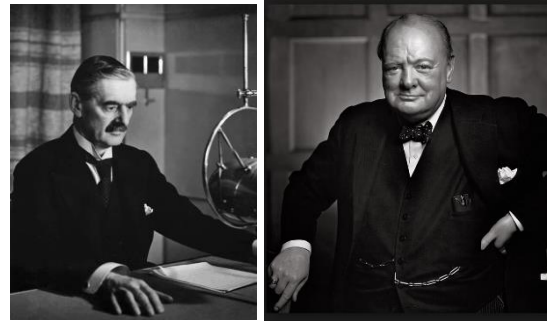
Resolution- to resolve a conflict

Nazi- Party run by Adolf Hitler

Prejudice- To treat people differently based on their race, religion or physical differences. During WWII Adolf Hitler hated the Jews based on their religion.

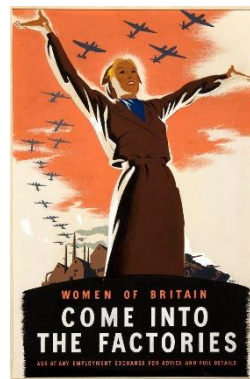
Axis Power- a military coalition that started WW2- Nazi Germany, Japan and Italy
