Legacy- Something handed from one period of time to another

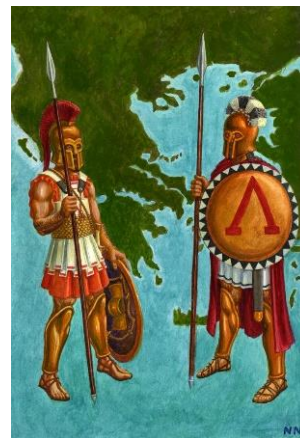
Military- soldiers or armed forces
