Manor Adventure – Culmington Manor

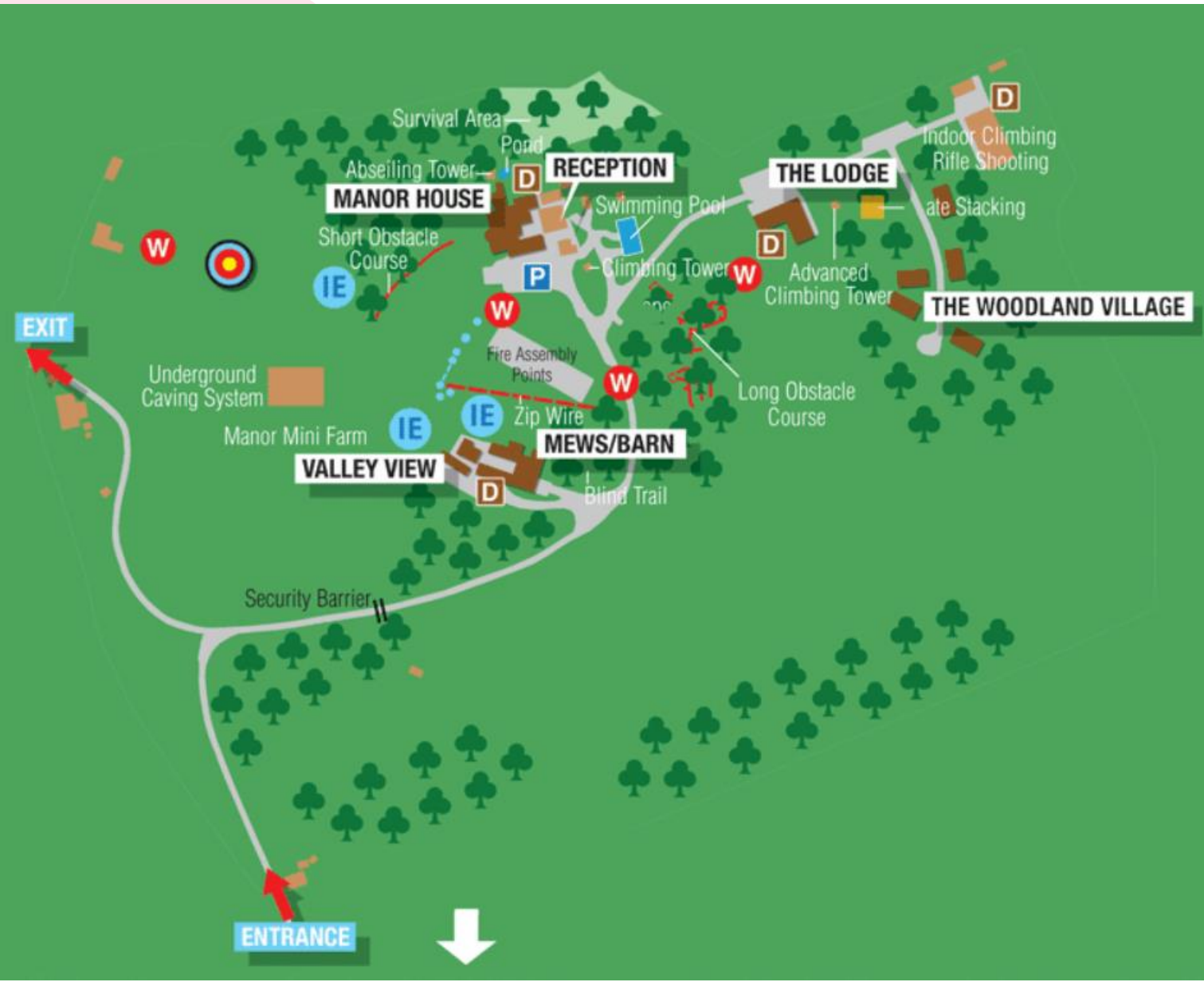

-One suitcase per child

Clothing

-OLD clothes (ALL labelled!) Long sleeved shirts/jumpers, trousers/jogging bottoms (no denim), T-shirts, shorts, underwear

-Underwear and socks

-Optional disco clothes
