Dear Parent and Carers of children in years 4, 5 and 6 in September 2024.

Its that time of year again to sign up for the Young Voices concert which will be on **Monday 13th January 2025** at the Resorts World Arena, Birmingham. Places are limited so not all children will be selected to attend. This also means that you should only apply if you are willing to attend Glee Club and all the rehearsals and the final performance.

The children who have been before will know that the Young Voice Concert is a great experience. For those of you that haven't, here is just a brief outline of what to expect on the day. A massed choir of 7,000 children perform together a wide range of songs and medleys from across the musical spectrum. The children will also have the chance to perform with guest artists. On **Monday 13th January 2025**, the children will travel by coach for an afternoon rehearsal at the Resorts World Arena in preparation for the evening concert which starts around 7pm. The concert usually finishes at 9pm and we are normally back at school around 10.30pm (traffic permitting)

If selected to attend this year's Young voices, the cost will be **£12.50** which includes coach hire. There will also be the option to purchase children's t-shirts. Parents will also have the opportunity to purchase tickets to come and watch the concert.

By signing up to Young Voices, your child is committed to attending weekly rehearsals held on **Monday's after school** and the concert at the Resorts World Arena on **Monday 13th January 2025**. Rehearsals will commence in September (date to be confirmed) Children will be expected to practise their words and dance moves (all available on the young voices website) between rehearsals to be performance ready.

If your child would like the opportunity to perform at the Young Voices concert, please sign up to this via ParentPay. Places are limited therefore if Glee Club is over-subscribed, priority will be given in year group order working backwards from year 6.
