Where are we staying?

We will stay at a Premier Inn Hanger Lane with bed and breakfast board. The hotels are situated North West of London, with easy access to the city by private coach. The rooms will be located on the same corridor and staff will 'bookend' the rooms. Children will be assigned into rooms of 2 or 3. We will eat breakfast at the hotel and be provided packed lunches by The London Lunchbox Company.

However, you will need a packed lunch for our first day (Wednesday). Our evening meals will be in restaurants (please see itinerary tbc).

How will we travel around London?

Executive Transport is booked to take us from place to place around London as well as transporting us there and back. Our hotel is slightly out of the city centre so we will have a 30 minute drive in and out of the city each day and night.

Whenever children are off the bus, they will all wear individual high visibility jackets and walk in assigned pairs with assigned groups to an adult. They will also wear a lanyard with a card with the school number and with contact details on it to make the public aware that we are a school group. When visiting museums, we will split into smaller groups with adults but otherwise will always stay as one group. As a group, we will follow each individual attraction's rules and risk assessment.

Administration of Medicine

We request that every child attends the trip with calpol authorisation to receive school medication (as an emergency back-up), an online medical form to be completed by all. Any other medication to be supplied at a drop off clinic prior to the trip with completed form. The registered first aiders will keep all medication for the duration of the trip. Those children on our medical register will have all the medication we hold in school already. We will administer as instructed on your medical form. All unused medication will be returned back to you at the end of the trip.

How will we stay in touch?

Texts, website and Facebook! We will constantly upload photos to the schools Facebook adhering to media permissions and let you know what we've been up to via text. Staff on the trip will be contactable at all times via email so do not hesitate to get in touch if you have any worries or concerns, big or small!

Ms Simmonds is listed as emergency school contact for out of hours as well. Children must **NOT** bring phones *or any other technology* with them on the trip – they will be far too busy! Cameras are allowed but brought at your own risk.

07:30 - Depart from school via coach provided by NST.

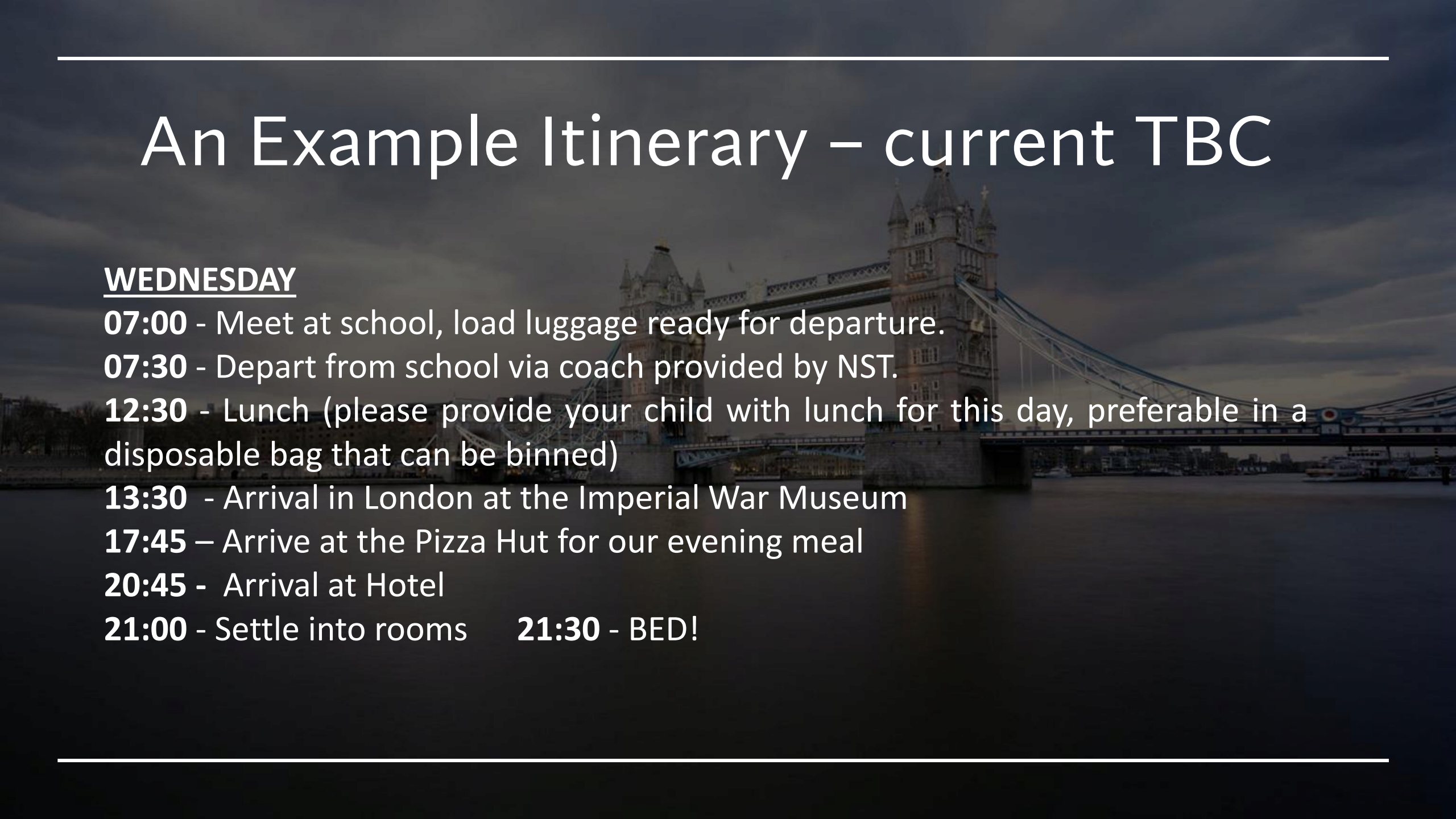
12:30 - Lunch (please provide your child with lunch for this day, preferable in a disposable bag that can be binned)
