### **Written statement of behaviour principles**

***At Red Hill CE Primary School, our ethos is based around the following principles:***

- Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and learn free from the disruption of others;
- All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination;
- Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times;
- Staff and pupils have respectful relationships with each other at all times, this includes all spoken language and actions;
- Rewards, sanctions and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy;
- The behaviour policy is understood by pupils, staff and Governors;
- Consequences should be known, understood and applied fairly, consistently, proportionally and reasonably;
- The Suspensions and Exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in suspensions and exclusions;
- Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions;
- Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life;

The Governing Body also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour towards pupils or adults will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the full governing body every 2 years.
