

### 30 House Points

- Research about a specific refugee crisis in the world. This could be a current crisis or a historical one. Write a report detailing the causes, effects and international response.
- Read stories or watch documentaries about individuals who have experienced being a refugee. Write a summary of their experiences and discuss how it made you feel.
- Create a piece of artwork which represents the journey of a refugee. Write a summary paragraph explaining your symbolism.
- Write a moving poem from the perspective of a refugee capturing their hopes, fears and experiences.
- Build a refugee camp model/diorama with labels for different areas (housing, food distribution, medical facilities etc)
- Draw a map showing the journey of a refugee from their home country to their host country.
- Research and present the international laws and conventions related to the refugee crisis.

### 5 House Points

- Create a timeline of a specific refugee crisis marking the key events and turning points.
- Create a fact sheet about refugee statistics and the rights they have in the UK.

### 3 House Points (Maths)

In maths we have been focusing angles and geometry. Please consolidate your learning at home by going on an 'angle classification hunt' around your home, drawing shapes and identifying angles within those shapes or you might want to have a go at designing a map using co-ordinates.

### 15 House Points:

- Create a poster that raises awareness about the challenges refugees face. This could include issues such as access to housing, education and health care.
- Write a formal letter to a local representative expressing concern for the current refugee crisis and suggest ways the community can help refugees around our area.
- Conduct a geographical study by looking at a world map and identifying countries with the most refugees and research the reasoning behind this.
- Create a business plan to raise awareness of the refugee crisis through a fundraiser or charity event.
- Write a diary entry about the day and life of a refugee which includes their journey, living conditions and future aspirations.
- Create a glossary of topic specific vocabulary or words associated with the refugee crisis with definitions.
- Create a quiz to raise awareness of the refugee crisis. This could include multiple choice or true/false questioning.
