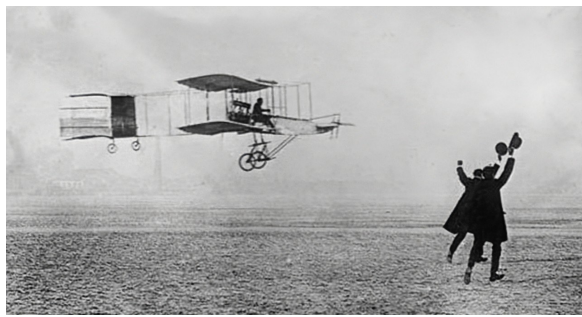


Summer 2 house point project

DT

Gather some foods together, have a go at tasting them and decide whether they are sweet or savoury. 5 points

Prepare a fruit salad and have a go at carefully cutting and preparing the fruit you use. 5 points.

Write instructions on how to make a fruit salad. 10 points

Create a poster explaining why fruit and vegetables are important. 5 points

MATHS

Create a map of a room in your house or your garden.

Pick 5 objects you can see and draw them on your map.

Then give someone verbal instructions using language such as turn left and right, forwards and backwards to get to each object. 5 points.

Set up some races with the people in your house and use ordinal number to determine the result (first, second, third). 5 points.

Use number cards from 0-9 to create a 2 digit number eg 62 then create another 2 digit number and compare using same as, greater than and less than. 5 points

History

Research the Wright Brothers and record 3 facts about them and a picture. 10 points.

Go on a walk or in your garden and count how many birds/ flying creatures you can spot. Take photos of them if you can. 5 points.

Make 3 paper aeroplanes in different ways/ different sizes— carry out a test to see which flies the furthest. 10 points.

Make your own flying machine out of junk. 10 points.

Carry out a survey about the types of transport

SCIENCE

Go for a walk in your local area and spot as many wildflowers as you can. Use your computing skills and take photos of what you find. 5 points

Make a junk model flower and label the different parts—stem, flower, roots and leaves. 5 points.



PHONICS AND READING

Read a bedtime story to a grown up instead of them reading it to you. 5 points

Read/share a book whose front cover is your favourite colour. 5 points.

Read a book in the dark with a torch and some snacks. 5 points

Work on reading words containing these split diagraphs - u-e (flute), o-e (bone), a-e (shake) e-e (swede) i-e (bike) 5 points
